## **RESOLUTION No. 5**

## 150<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE NATIONAL GEOGRAPHIC INSTITUTE OF SPAIN

The 50th Meeting of the Directing Council of the Pan American Institute for Geography and History (PAIGH), in its virtual mode,

### CONSIDERING:

The fact that, since 1994 the Kingdom of Spain has been a Permanent Observer of the PAIGH, with its National Geographic Institute (IGN) sustaining the link that the PAIGH has with that country;

The invaluable contribution received throughout the last 26 years from the IGN in tasks involving training, guidance and advice, also participation in the execution of projects;

The invitation from the IGN as host of the 50th Meeting of the Directing Council of the PAIGH, which could no longer take place in Spain due to the pandemic;

The fact that on the 12th of September, 2020, the IGN has celebrated 150 years since its foundation;

The recommendations of the 94th Meeting of the Authorities,

#### RESOLVES TO:

- 1. Give thanks to the Kingdom of Spain and in particular to the National Geographic Institute, for the valuable support received since its inclusion as a Permanent Observer Country of the PAIGH.
- 2. Congratulate the National Geographic Institute on the occasion of its 150th Anniversary and express certainty that it will continue to develop permanently over the coming years.
- 3. Continue to encourage and strengthen the links for scientific-technical cooperation existing between the National Geographic Institute of Spain and the Pan American Institute for Geography and History, focusing on proactive, innovative and synergistic approaches.
