He was one of the first professional historians of the American Union. He revolutionized the historiography of the United States when he proposed a “multicausal” model that recognizes the political, economic, cultural and geographic interaction within a single historic event. He considered that the frontier of the United States had a fundamental role within the history of that country, given that it was there that the social American development consolidated.
