One of the main protagonists in the process of emancipation in Latin America. After participating in the Cuban independence movements, he was deported to Spain, where he studied Law, Philosophy, and Literature at the University of Zaragoza. Although he is primarily recognized for his insurgent spirit, Martí gained international prominence in the field of literature, becoming one of the most renowned poets in the Americas. Among his lesser-known facets, his interest in natural sciences, especially seismology, stands out.
