He was outstanding in the drafting of biographic studies about several leaders of Honduras. He graduated with a first degree in judicial and legal discipline and taught the subjects of political law, economic policies, and statistics at the National University, this being an institution at which he became its rector. His commitment to education gained for him the appointment of Secretary of State in the Public Education Office. He participated as delegate in the conference on boundaries between Honduras and Nicaragua.
