### **Resolution 10**

#### **APPRECIATION TO THE NATIONAL SECTION OF URUGUAY FOR ITS CONTRIBUTION IN MATTERS OF SCIENTIFIC ADVICE AND TRAINING FOR THE BELIZE-GUATEMALA ADJACENCY ZONE OVER SEVERAL YEARS**

The 26<sup>th</sup> General Assembly of the Pan American Institute of Geography and History (PAIGH), held in the city of Tegucigalpa, Honduras.

Considering:

- The fact that making the performance of the PAIGH efficient in the fulfilment of its Mission, Vision and Principles is necessary;
- The fact that the Director of the Office of the General Secretariat of the Organization of American States in the Belize-Guatemala Adjacency Zone has requested, of the PAIGH, training in matters of cartography;
- The fact that the coordination of the General Secretariat with the PAIGH Member States was for selecting the human resources that would provide the training and, at all times, avoid affecting the sovereignty of the nations and governments involved in the Belize-Guatemala Adjacency Zone;
- The fact that the Director of the Military Geographic Institute of Uruguay, headquarters of the National Section, designated one of the members of that institute to carry out the training in cartography with the handling of ArcGIS Pro to the staff of the Verification Team of the Office of the General Secretariat of the Organization of American States in the Belize-Guatemala Adjacency Zone;
- The fact that the training contributed to strengthening the Verification System of the Office of the General Secretariat of the Organization of American States

- The recommendations of the 103<sup>rd</sup> and 104<sup>th</sup> Meetings of PAIGH Authorities and of the Administrative Policy Committee,

Resolves to:

- First: Instruct the Secretary General to state in writing, a warm and cordial recognition and thanks from the PAIGH and the Pan American Community to the people and Government of Uruguay, also to the Director of the Military Geographic Institute of Uruguay, headquarters of the National Section, emphasizing their generosity and commitment to putting into effect the training in the territory of the Belize-Guatemala Adjacency Zone and thus contributing to keeping the peace in the region.
- Second: Grant recognition as an expression of thanks to the National Section of Uruguay, for its praiseworthy contribution to peace and to the scientific community of America.
