PRESENTATION OF THE REPORTS FROM THE NATIONAL SECTIONS OF THE PAN AMERICAN INSTITUTE OF GEOGRAPHY AND HISTORY CORRESPONDING TO 2025

The 26th General Assembly of the Pan American Institute of Geography and History (PAIGH), held in the city of Tegucigalpa, Honduras,

Considering:

- The fact that making the performance of the PAIGH efficient in the fulfilment of its Mission, Vision and Principles is necessary;
