**Resolution 1**

**SUPPORT FOR THE PAN AMERICAN AGENDA  
OF THE PAIGH 2023-2030**

The 26<sup>th</sup> General Assembly of the Pan American Institute of Geography and History (PAIGH), held in the city of Tegucigalpa, Honduras.

Considering:

- The fact that the 2023-2030 Pan American Agenda was authorized by means of Resolution 1 of the 25<sup>th</sup> General Assembly (Santiago, Chile, November 19<sup>th</sup>-21<sup>st</sup>, 2024), which resolves upon seven strategic points in scientific and administrative matters, the benefits for the Member States, and communities of specialists, which are the essence of the Pan American Agenda;
- The fact that the 2023-2030 Pan American Agenda is based on the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) of the United Nations Organization (UN);
- The fact that, in view of the period of reflection on the coming centenary of the Institute, the support of the PAIGH Authorities, Commissions, Committees, Working Groups, National Sections of the Member States, Observer States, and international organizations are all required in order to make the decisions and specifications of the 2023-2030 Pan American Agenda of the PAIGH a reality, in matters of scientific research and administrative aspects;
- That recommended by the 103<sup>rd</sup> and 104<sup>th</sup> Meeting of PAIGH Authorities and by the Scientific Policy Committee,

Resolves to:

Sole resolution: Instruct the Secretary General to, as far as is possible and using the human, material, legal, financial, administrative and scientific resources of the PAIGH, request the support of the National Sections of the PAIGH Member States, also of the Observer States, of the United
