#### **Resolution 3**

# ANNUAL QUOTAS OF THE MEMBER STATES OF THE PAN AMERICAN INSTITUTE OF GEOGRAPHY AND HISTORY FOR THE YEAR 2026

The 26<sup>th</sup> General Assembly of the Pan American Institute of Geography and History (PAIGH), held in the city of Tegucigalpa, Honduras.

#### Considering:

- The fact that the economic basis that sustains the PAIGH is made up from the annual quotas that the Member States provide, approved by the General Assembly;
- The fact that Article 55 of the Organic Statute of the PAIGH establishes that the quotas are calculated considering the following policies: "the minimum membership quota of any Member State of the general budget is 0.5%; and the maximum membership quota of any Member State may not exceed 49.99% of the general budget";
- The fact that the adjustment to the scale of quotas took effect from 2020, approved at the 48<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Directing Council (Santa Cruz de la Sierra, Bolivia, October 22<sup>nd</sup> 26<sup>th</sup> 2018);
- The fact that the world has been emerging from a pandemic that affected the economy of all the nations of the Earth, including the American Continent;
- The fact that all the Member States make a continual effort to fulfil their financial obligations to the PAIGH;
- The recommendations of the 103<sup>rd</sup> and 104<sup>th</sup> Meetings of PAIGH Authorities and of the Financial Policy Committee.

First: To maintain, for the year 2026, the same scale of quotas approved for the year 2021, in accordance with the following table:
