Resolution 9

APPRECIATION TO THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF STATISTICS AND GEOGRAPHY (INEGI) OF MEXICO FOR ITS CONTRIBUTIONS IN MATTERS OF TRAINING TO THE MEMBER STATES OF THE PAN AMERICAN INSTITUTE OF GEOGRAPHY AND HISTORY

The 26th General Assembly of the Pan American Institute of Geography and History (PAIGH), held in the city of Tegucigalpa, Honduras.

Considering:

- The fact that making the performance of the PAIGH efficient in the fulfilment of its Mission, Vision and Principles is necessary;
- The fact that the National Geographic and Cadastral Institute, headquarters of the PAIGH National Section in El Salvador has requested, of the PAIGH General Secretariat, training in matters of Territorial Information and Photogrammetry;
- The fact that the coordination of the General Secretariat with the PAIGH Member States was for selecting the human resources that would provide the training and avoid, at all times, affecting each public or private institute in their own activities;
- The fact that the National Institute for Statistics and Geography (INEGI) of Mexico, through its Director of International Affairs responded that they were able to provide the training in virtual mode to the staff of the National Geographic and Cadastral Institute, headquarters of the PAIGH National Section in El Salvador;
- The fact that the training put into effect by the National Institute for Statistics and Geography (INEGI), over the period from the month of April to October

to the year 2024, covered 22 areas and issues related to Territorial Information and Photogrammetry, contributing to the strengthening of the information of the National Registry Center of El Salvador;

Resolves to:

First:

Instruct the Secretary General to state in writing, a warm and cordial recognition and thanks from the PAIGH and the Pan American Community to the National Institute for Statistics and Geography of Mexico, for putting into effect the training in Territorial Information and Photogrammetry for the staff of the National Geographic and Cadastral Institute, headquarters of the PAIGH National Section in El Salvador.

Grant recognition as an expression of thanks to the National Institute for Statistics and Geography of Mexico, for its praiseworthy contribution to the scientific community of America.
