RESOLUTION No. 8

CONVENE THE ELECTION OF PAIGH AUTHORITIES FOR THE TIME PERIOD 2022-2025

The 50th Meeting of the Directing Council of the Pan American Institute for Geography and History (PAIGH), in its virtual mode,

CONSIDERING:

Article 15 of the PAIGH Organic Statutes, where the conditions to have positions of Authority of the Institute are established;

Article 22 of the PAIGH Organic Statutes, where the requirements of the Secretary General of the Institute election are established;

Article 27 of the cited statute, where the conditions for the election of the Commission Presidents are established;

What is established in Articles 28 and 29 of the PAIGH Financial Rules of Procedure, where the requirements are fixed to postulate the positions of Authority and requirements to have a right to vote in the election processes of the Institute;

The Call distributed by the General Secretariat on March 13, 2020;

The recommendations of the 93rd and 94th Meetings of Authorities,

RESOLVES:

1. To reiterate the call for Member States to submit candidates to the following positions for the 2022-2025 period:
 - President
 - Vice President
 - Secretary General
 - President and Vice President of the Cartography Commission
 - President and Vice President of the Geography Commission
 - President and Vice President of the History Commission
 - President and Vice President of the Geophysics Commission

The call to receive applications at the General Secretariat will be valid from October 5, 2020 to May 4, 2021.

The postulations should contain the following documents:

- An official memo written by their respective Chancellery
 - CV of the postulant crediting the established requirements in the PAIGH regulations
 - Work Plan for the period in which they would be in the position (2022-2025)
2. To request to the General Secretariat to make the highest possible distribution of this convocation.
