His book *Summary of the History of the Fatherland* is considered to be, so far, the official text for Dominican basic-level school education. In 1895 he travelled to Europe to study at the Sorbonne university, and five years later he returned to his country to work in several governmental secretariats. His labors in history had input from the historian José Gabriel García and a skilled writing style that held the attention of the non-specialized reader.
